Privacy Policy

Forktime Pty Ltd is committed to keeping your information safe and secure in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (the “Privacy Act”) and the National Privacy Principles contained therein.

1 Collection of Personal Information

1.1 Forktime Pty Ltd may collect and use the following kinds of information:

- (a) Information about your use of the website (including browser type; version and language; operating system; pages viewed while browsing the website; page access times; and referring website address);
- (b) Information about your personal details (including name; phone contact details; address information; email; username; password; and payment information); and
- (c) Any information necessary to provide services to you (the “Services”).

2 Use and Disclosure of Personal Information

2.1 Forktime Pty Ltd may use your personal information to:

- (a) enable your access to the Services;
- (b) track usage and measure traffic statistics for maintenance of a third party server with respect to the Services;
- (c) supply to you the Services;
- (d) contact you regarding your use of the Services;
- (e) contact you in relation to dispute resolution;
- (f) collect payments from you; and
- (g) send you marketing communications.

2.2 Forktime Pty Ltd will not disclose personal information about you unless it is related to the primary purpose of providing the Services to you.

3 Security and Accuracy

3.1 It is important that you advise Forktime Pty Ltd of changes to your personal information as it is essential that your personal information is accurate, complete, and up-to-date in order for Forktime Pty Ltd to provide the Services to you.

3.2 Forktime Pty Ltd uses reasonable technical precautions and has implemented business processes to protect your personal information from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, modification and disclosure.

3.3 Forktime Pty Ltd may disclose your personal information to third parties if you have purchased relevant services which requires third party services.

3.4 Forktime Pty Ltd may disclose your personal information to the extent that it is required to do so by law, in connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings, and in order to establish, exercise or defend its legal rights.

3.5 Forktime Pty Ltd will destroy or permanently de-identify personal information if it is no longer needed for the purposes of providing the Services to you.

4 Access and Correction

4.1 As a customer of Forktime Pty Ltd, you can modify or erase the personal information Forktime Pty Ltd stores about you. You are responsible to ensure that the information you provide to Forktime Pty Ltd is accurate, complete and up-to-date.

5 Identifiers and Anonymity

5.1 Forktime Pty Ltd will not identify you based on identifiers that may be given to use via your personal information (I.E Australian Government identifiers (Medicare)).

5.2 Forktime Pty Ltd provides a personalised service to you as a customer and your name and contact details must be accurate.

6 Trans-border Data Flows

6.1 Forktime Pty Ltd will only transfer personal information to someone who is in a foreign country if:

(a) Forktime Pty Ltd reasonably believes that the recipient of the information is subject to a law, binding scheme or contract which effectively upholds principles for fair handling of the information that are substantially similar to the National Privacy Principles; or

- (b) the individual consents to the transfer; or
 - (c) the transfer is necessary for the performance of a contract between you and Forktime Pty Ltd, or for the implementation of pre-contractual measures taken in response to your request; or
 - (d) the transfer is necessary for the conclusion or performance of a contract concluded in your interest between Forktime Pty Ltd and a third party; or
 - (e) all of the following apply:
 - (i) the transfer is for your benefit;
 - (ii) it is impracticable to obtain your consent to that transfer; and
 - (iii) if it were practicable to obtain such consent, you would be likely to give it;
- or
- (f) Forktime Pty Ltd has taken reasonable steps to ensure that the information which it has transferred will not be held, used or disclosed by the recipient of the information inconsistently with the National Privacy Principles.

7 Sensitive Information

7.1 Sensitive information is defined in the Privacy Act to include information or opinion about such things as an individual's racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, membership of a political association, religious or philosophical beliefs, membership of a trade union or other professional body, criminal record or health information.

7.2 Sensitive information will be used by Forktime Pty Ltd only for the primary purpose for which it was obtained; for a secondary purpose that is directly related to the primary purpose; with your consent; or where required or authorised by law.

8 Openness

8.1 By request, you may contact Forktime Pty Ltd and ask to know what sort of personal information is held about you, for what purposes, and how it is collected, held, used and disclosed.
